The SETTING

- 1. How does grace work to distance the believer from sin? Compare Titus 2:11-12.
- 2. Why is it necessary for believers to separate from the old lifestyle of sin? Compare 1 John 1:6-7.

The WORDING

- 1. In verse 5, what does it mean for the believer to be "planted" together with the Lord Jesus in his death and resurrection? Use blueletterbible.org or a strong's concordance to define the word.
- 2. In verse 6, what is the meaning of the word "destroyed." How does this help the believer avoid staying a slave to sin? Use blueletterbible.org or a strong's concordance to define the word.

The MEANING

- 1. Why is it strange for a believer to remain in the practice of sin? Compare 2 Timothy 2:19.
- 2. How does being under the law allow sin to have dominion over you? Compare Romans 5:13 and Galatians 5:4.

The LIVING

- 1. How do we yield ourselves as instruments for God? Compare Romans 12:1.
- 2. What are practical steps to ensuring the old man stays dead? Compare Colossians 3:5 and research the word "mortify" using blueletterbible.org or a strong's concordance.
