- 2. According to this verse, how should we "mortify" the flesh? Compare Galatians 3:3.

## The MEANING

- 1. What action reveals that a believer belongs to the family of God? Compare John 1:12.
- 2. Why is it necessary to include suffering as a part of being joint heirs in the family of God? Compare Acts 14:21-22.

## The LIVING

- 1. How do we maintain sensitivity to the Holy Spirit? Compare Ephesians 4:25-30.
- 2. What are practical ways to keep in step with the Holy Spirit? Compare Galatians 5:16-26.
