## The WORDING

- 1. According to verse 2, what type of "knowledge" helps to balance zeal? Use blueletterbible.org or a Strong's concordance to define the word.
- 2. How does absence of this type of knowledge of the Savior lead to ignorance and a doctrine of works? Compare Ephesians 1:18-19.

## The MEANING

- 1. What does it mean in verse 4 that "Christ is the end of the law?" Compare Matthew 5:17.
- 2. In verse 9-10, how does confession lead to salvation? Compare 1 John 1:9 and Proverbs 28:13.

## The LIVING

- 1. What are practical steps to avoiding spiritual ignorance? Compare James 1:21.
- 2. How do we grow in the righteousness that is of faith? Compare 2 Cor 5:21 and Romans 13:14.
