- 2. What then is the difference between thinking highly and soberly of oneself?

The MEANING

- 1. Why is it important to correct our thinking before attempting to be a blessing? Compare 1 Corinthians 8:1.
- 2. Why is love essential for the believer's personal and community rebuild? Compare 1 Corinthians 13:8.

The LIVING

- 1. What important word should be considered to become a living sacrifice or a blessing? Hint: it's in this sentence.
- 2. What practical ways can we prefer one another above our needs? Compare Philippians 2:3-5.
