- 2. How could our good be spoken of as evil? Compare Romans 14:15.

The LIVING

- 1. How can we walk consistently in love? Compare 1 John 3:14-18.
- 2. What practical ways can we avoid placing stumbling blocks in the path of another? Compare Ephesians 5:15.
