The SETTING

- 1. How did Abraham live out his faith in what the Lord promised? Compare Romans 4:18-20.
- 2. As with Abraham, what does an active faith provide for the believer? Compare Hebrews 11:2.

The WORDING

- 1. In verse 1 and 2, what two words describe the benefits the believer has through faith? Compare Ephesians 1:6 and John 1:12.
- 2. In verse 4, how is the word "experience" (KJV) tied to refined character? Compare James 1:3-4.

The MEANING

- 1. According to verse 3-5, how do the pressures of life produce stronger faith? Compare 2 Corinthians 12:9-10.
- 2. Why is the promise of verse 9 so critical to understanding the benefits of salvation in Jesus Christ? Compare 1 Thessalonians 5:9.

The LIVING

- 1. What are practical ways the believer can cherish access to God? Compare Hebrews 4:16.
- 2. What is a different way to approach problems if they can grow faith? Compare James 1:2.
