- 2. How does showing mercy help break down a resistant heart? Compare Luke 6:35-36.

The LIVING

- 1. How do we allow our lifestyle to be a witness more than our words? Compare 1 Peter 2:11-12.
- 2. What are practical steps to growing in mercy? Compare Matthew 11:29.
