## The SETTING

- 1. In verse 16, what is the meaning of the word "servant?" Use blueletterbible.org or a strong's concordance to define the word.
- 2. How does this word provide a picture of how the believer is to act in his service to God? Compare Deuteronomy 15:16-17.

## The MEANING

- 1. In verse 17, why does the writer use the past tense when referring to "the servants of sin?" Compare Ephesians 4:22.
- 2. How does yielding ourselves for God's use contribute to becoming more like Christ? Compare 1 Peter 1:13-16.

## The LIVING

- 1. What main discipline will help us to be servants of righteousness? Compare Romans 6:17.
- 2. How do we ensure we are instruments that the Lord can use? Compare 2 Timothy 2:19-21.
